The artist is responsible to initiate and pay for all shipping charges to and from Bold Expressions Exhibit. If there is a delay in the return shipping, the NCA shipping agent will call you. You may ship your work upon receipt of this letter. There is no fee for shipping.

Let your shipper know that the center Gallery Hours are: 11:00-7:00pm Tuesday; Wednesday - Friday 11:00-3pm; Saturday and Sunday 11:00-5:00pm. Closed on Mondays.

Please include a prepaid pick up order from your shipper for return of your artwork. Place the prepaid pick up order form inside your crate/box. A personal account may be opened through a credit card. **MAKE SURE YOUR NAME IS ON THE PICK UP ORDER**, and also the name and address of where the crate is to be returned is on the box. If you want extra insurance be sure to include the amount in your pick up order.

If you need to make other arrangements please contact Paul Desseau at the telephone number or e-mail listed above.

Outside the United States: You will need to contact a Freight Forwarding Company or a Customs Broker for the right procedure to ship and for return of your artwork.
